Our delicious Cabernet Sauvignon is a style that reflects modern Oakville, while at the same time captures the classic flavors of the region. With the 2010 vintage, we were very fortunate that the fruit did not suffer from the extremely hot weather, because they were protected by the canopy. Well balanced with intense fruit and intense color. Showcasing black berry and cassis aromatics this vintage shows hints of violets, tobacco and eucalyptus. On the palate it is very round and seductive. It starts with a lively grip and gains size and depth as it opens up. The gutsy character of this wine will be a perfect compliment to hearty dishes, but can also stand on its own. Will age well, drink now through 2022.
